

Announcement of Narathiwat Municipality Regarding the policy of not accepting gifts and gifts of any kind from performing duties (No Gift Policy)

According to the Cabinet resolution on December 8, 2020, the Cabinet approved the national reform plan on prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (revised version) by specifying the drive to implement important reform activities (Big Rock), reform activity 4, developing the Thai civil service system to be transparent and without benefits.Which is the goal 1, item 1.1 "For all government agencies to declare themselves as agencies where all government officials do not accept gifts and gifts of any kind from performing duties (No Gift Policy)".

In this regard, to drive reform activities according to the reform plan above, create transparency within the agency, create values in performing duties, and should be practiced as a culture of honesty of Narathiwat Municipality, it is hereby announced A policy that all executives, employees, officers, and personnel under the organization will not accept gifts and gifts of any kind while/before/after performing duties that will result in corruption and misconduct on all festivals and special occasions, except in cases where it is necessary and unavoidable. The criteria for accepting gifts or gifts must be followed. and other benefits in accordance with the Prime Minister's Regulations on the Giving or Receiving of Gifts by Government Officials B.E. 2 5 4 4, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the Criteria for the Acceptance of Property or Other Benefits by Government Officials Ethically B.E. 2563

It is hereby announced for general information and for all executives, employees, officers and personnel under the organization to strictly comply with the policy.
